If you do continue this trend though, consider informing the class that an assignment will be posted the night of the class. Additionally, when the video on Buddhism didn't work you kinda got caught off guard and stumbled. When dealing with technology such as videos, PowerPoint or others, have a contingency plan in the event it doesn't work. Finally, remember that in this day and age Theology is a TOUGH subject to teach. This is an era where an increasing amount of students don't associate with any kind of religion, and the trend may continue to expand. Yes this a Catholic Lasallian university but don't assume that because of that the students you teach will all be interested in the subject. Some students (myself included) came to this university because of the impressive credentials the professors have, not because of its religious affiliation. Don't be discouraged that some people aren't as attentive that you would like, I noticed that you kinda got dejected at some points near the end of the class when people were tired. My suggestions are: Keep things upbeat, don't have assignments in bulk (rather spread them out), consider having a bit more variety in the types of essay assignments (like when I did a critical analysis of Decartes rather than a compare and contrast (which I now realize is what both of your essays focused on)), cover a bit more religions (you spent a fair bit of time on Christianity, a little on Judaism, and a bit less on Buddhism. May I suggest expanding to Hinduism, Greek mythology, Deism or even the antithesis of your class: Atheism? The last two may be a bit harder to cover, as there isn't much to them, but you could cover famous people who were in those categories, even the philosophies of those people (from my perspective, just because I'm an Atheist does not mean I don't follow a moral code; which one is my biggest pet peeves is when people justifying doing the right thing by saying "I'm a Christian man/woman."))(Also, a final exam that focuses on an essay is, in my opinion, a terrible idea. Not because the assessment could be potentially difficult (though that's a factor to consider when people are pressured in an exam room where they may blank on the subjects covered in class), but because having the students write extensively can cause wrist pain, cramping and/or minds to wander when trying to think of where to go next in the essay.)
